3 on 3 Basketball Rules

Rosters

- 1. Rosters may consist of a minimum of three (3) players and a maximum of five (5) players. Teams will be placed in one of three brackets: 15 and Under, 19 and under and Open Division. Teams that have mixed ages must play in the Open Division.
- 3. Rosters must be submitted to the tournament director in advance. All changes to the roster must be pre-approved by the tournament director.
- 4. Rosters may not be changed or adjusted once games begin.
- 5. Illegal rosters or players may result in forfeiture at the discretion of the tournament director.

Game Play

- 1. Games will consist of two seven (7) minute halves, running time or first team to 15pts.
- 2. In the event of a tied game, a one (1) minute overtime session will take place. A maximum of three overtime periods can be played to determine a winner. If a winner is not determined by the end of the third overtime, the next team to score will be declared the winner.
- 3. Teams will not have any timeouts during the game. The only stoppage of play will be in the event of injury or at the discretion of the tournament director/game official.
- 4. A coin toss will determine who gets the ball at the beginning of each game and at the beginning of an overtime session.
- 5. Regular baskets are worth 1 point and shots behind the arc are worth 2 points. Free throws are worth 1 point each.

Game Rules

- 1. After a score, the defensive team will take possession of the ball at the top of the key (loser's out).
- 2. All change of possession (steals, air balls, rebounds, etc.) must be cleared outside the three point arc. Once the ball is cleared, the team may attack the basket and score.
- 3. One foul shot will be awarded on fouls that occur while a player is in the act of shooting.
- 4. All other fouls will be a dead ball and the offensive team will keep possession and begin play at the top of the key.
- 5. Fouls that occur in the last two minutes of the game will result in a 1-and-1 foul shot. (This prevents a team from milking the clock in the final minutes.)
- 6. Technical fouls will result in two shots and loss of possession. Two technical fouls received by the same player will result in ejection from the tournament. Maximum of 3 technical fouls for the tournament before ejection from the tournament.
- 7. All disputes will be handled by game officials and/or the tournament director.
- 8. Tournament format will be determined based on the number of teams entered.
